b. <u>Resolution #2024-035 – Motion to approve budget transfers</u>

On motion of Commissioner Barry, seconded by Commissioner Matteson, the following resolution was adopted: 5 Ayes; 0 Nays

WHEREAS, to maintain balanced budget lines within the 2024 budget, Treasurer McAdoo recommended inter-budget transfers as fully described in Attachment A; and,

WHEREAS the Board of Fire Commissioners have reviewed and discussed the transfers and found they are consistent with good financial practices; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED the Board of Fire Commissioners approve the inter-budget transfers as shown.

c. <u>Resolution #2024-036 – Authorization for Firefighters to Attend Crash Course</u>

On motion of Commissioner McConnell, seconded by Commissioner Kowal, the following resolution was adopted: 5 Ayes; 0 Nays

WHEREAS, General Municipal Law 72-g and Victor Fire District Policies require training opportunities at the national level must be authorized by the Chief and approved by resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners prior to attendance;

WHEREAS, Crash Course Village, a 501(c)3 corporation, based in Dayton, Ohio, provides fire and rescue departments specialized rescue and extrication training;

WHEREAS, Chief Lamarco wishes to authorize two firefighters to be named at a later date to attend this training; and,

WHEREAS the Board of Fire Commissioners have reviewed the written justification for attending Crash Course, as shown in Attachment A, and finds that it is necessary, in the public interest, and provides training not available within a reasonable time period or distance within New York; therefore, now, be it

RESOLVED, the Board of Fire Commissioners authorizes Chief Lamarco to reserve two seats for the Crash Course utilizing one of the chief's vehicles on May 4 & 5, 2024, at Calamityville Training Complex, Fairborn, Ohio, including hotel rooms for two nights, utilizing 2763 for transportation;

RESOLVED; that Chief Lamarco submit the names of the recommended members to the Board of Fire Commissioners for their approval prior to the scheduled event;

RESOLVED, that the attendees are authorized to use one of District Credit Cards for expenses on the condition they review the travel policy with the Deputy Treasurer prior to departure and with the understanding that any expenses not determined to be consistent with the travel policy shall be refunded to the District within 30 days of notification; and,

RESOLVED that the expenses for this training will be assigned to A3410.403.11.7 Training - Crash Course.

d. <u>Resolution #2024-xxx – Approval of revised MOU with Victor Farmington Ambulance-</u> tabled

WHEREAS, Chief Lamarco has recommended updating the existing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Victor Fire District and the Victor Farmington Ambulance to accurately reflect the time an ambulance is staged and to clarify the communication procedure;

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners have reviewed a copy of the revised agreement, which is further described in Appendix A; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners approves the revised MOU with the Victor Farmington Ambulance; and

RESOLVED that the District Treasurer is authorized to execute any documents necessary for the completion of the filing of the MOU.

e. <u>Resolution #2024-037 – Approval of Revisions to the Procurement Policy</u>

RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners adopts the Revisions to the Procurement Policy; and,

RESOLVED that a copy of the attachments be made available to the members and staff of the Victor Fire District.

f. <u>Resolution #2024-0038 – Review of the Unassigned Fund Balance</u>

On motion of Commissioner McConnell, seconded by Commissioner Matteson, the following resolution was adopted: 5 Ayes; 0 Nays

WHEREAS, consistent with the New York State Comptroller's recommendations, the District's Budget and Fund Balance Policy requires the Board of Fire Commissioners to determine annually if the Unassigned Fund Balance meets or exceeds the established threshold;

WHEREAS, the Fire District Treasurer has prepared a report on the Unassigned Fund Balance from the end of the prior budget year showing an excess over the threshold of \$104,910, as fully described in Appendix A;

WHEREAS, the Fire District Treasurer recommends the following actions to reduce the potential of excessive tax levy increases:

- Transfer \$30,000 to A3410.901 Apparatus Reserve to support the objectives of the Apparatus Capital Plan
- Transfer \$30,000 to A3410.902 Building Reserve to support the objectives of the Building Capital Plan
- Transfer \$44,910 to A3410.903 Equipment Reserve to support the objectives of the Equipment Capital Plan

RESOLVED, that the Board of Fire Commissioners accept the recommendations of the Treasurer and directs the funds to be transferred into the reserves within 10 business days.

g. <u>Resolution #2024-038 – Resolution to Hold Joint Meeting with VFD, Inc. Board of</u> <u>Directors</u>

On motion of Commissioner McConnell, seconded by Commissioner Matteson the following resolution was adopted: 5 Ayes; 0 Nayes

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners recognizes that the Board of Directors of the Victor Fire Department, Inc., is a valuable partner in planning and preparing for the future of the Victor Fire District; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners will conducting a joint workshop with the Victor Fire Department, Inc. Board of Directors starting at 5:30 pm, prior to their regular business meeting on Tuesday, April 9, 2024, for the sole purpose of discussing vision and goals for the future;

RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be delivered to the Victor Fire Department Inc.; and

RESOLVED that the District Secretary Hauf make all necessary legal notifications for public posting.
